



Service Officer – May June 2017

If you have been attending our General Meetings, you are pretty much up to date. Our May event featured a report by Bill Coleman on "free" telephones for the hearing impaired. There are three sizes to choose from; each with a progressively larger built in screen that will display the callers words in print while amplifying the volume up to 4X normal. While a computer line is pre-

ferred, these devices can be connected by a regular telephone line or even with a cellular phone if that is your only option.

A one-time Veteran's fee of \$40.00 is waived by going through the VA system. There are applications in a folder on our Service table in the Club Room. You would show either Bill or myself your proof of hearing loss which we would use to authorize the application. The largest of the three phones has a speaker phone. All have answering machines built in.

Any American with hearing loss and a telephone system is eligible for these phones. Civilians pay a one-time \$75.00 set up fee. THERE ARE NO EXTRA MONTHLY CHARGES ON YOUR BILLS. A national tax we all pay covers the entire United States of America.

Footnote: THE PHONES ARE BUILT IN WISCONSIN, BY AMERICANS.


