



VSO's get information from many sources. More email than a sane mind can handle, it seems. Some of this info concerns job opportunities from either the VA or private concerns. I urge veterans in need of full time work to contact a VSO; the sooner the better. In Troy, there is a week-long training course in learning tools to find work. The graduates then meet with industry reps looking for veterans to fill their employee needs. This program is having success.

Post 1008, as with most of the VFW, has aging members with health needs. I want to emphasize we each make certain to share the knowledge. This month, I came across a life member, Vietnam service, USMC, transferring to our Post. I'd like to bring Bill Leshow to a meeting: if only his health improves. He was not on the VA radar at all. We fixed that with trips to Oakland County to file for a DD214, one to John Dingell Hospital to register, another to the Pontiac Clinic where I was directed to get him to the ER at Dingell. Different days. He's somewhat better, has the Agent Orange symptoms, and will be seen once again for a treatment program. I'm doing the driving but certainly would make room from time to time if there is a volunteer out there. He uses a walker but needs a wheelchair in hospital. He will be opening a VA claim.

I appreciate our members and the bar staff in consulting with guests and the referrals to myself or Bill Coleman. I prioritize veteran service over most anything else. The else being boat trips. As crew, I am obligated to make. Sailing is my relief valve and the season is short.


Let's hope for a beautiful Fall season and mild Winter.
